



the Mustafa science and technology Foundation holds the 5th annual Noor student competition in memory of the great scientist and mathematician of the Islamic world 'Aburayhan biruni associating Fan Amooz institution. this year in the 5th Noor student competition we accept 60 seconds scientific films in two different categories

1: general category: experiments and Vision and visual errors

2:special category: creating real and practical models for mathematical concepts.

rules®ulation

- students can participate only as in groups.
- Interested students can participate in this competition in groups of 2 or 3 students or with the participation of their family members.
- competition only communicate with group leader.
- the group leader has to be a student.
- participants can be part of one group only.
- After announcing the results of the competition, in case of winning, the documents of the winning group members will be matched with the registered information. In case of any incompatibility with the registered information, the group will be removed from the winners list.



- Submitted videos must be a maximum of 1 minute (60 seconds).
- Films with 61 seconds or more length will not be judged.
- The maximum acceptable file size is 40 MB.
- If the participation of the group members in the film is not evident, in addition to the main product, it is mandatory that groups send a few pictures or a documentary (1 minute max) from behind the scenes of the experiments.
- It is mandatory to mention the name or subject of the experiment at the beginning of the submitted videos.
- There are no limits to the number of scientific experiment films submitted by each group.
- If there is a scientific discrepancy in the information expressed in the work, the work will be removed from the competition.
- All works shall be received only through the website of the competition and the secretariat will not accept the works sent by DVDs or through competition social media.
- Films must be documented and films that are in the form of animation, motion graphics, PowerPoint, etc. will not be accepted.
- Submissions must be registered and uploaded by the end of the 31st of July 1401on the Noor student competition website at www.noor.mstfdn.org.
- following the Islamic rules and customary manners (in accordance with the regulations of the Ministry of Culture and Islamic Guidance and the Islamic Republic of Iran Broadcasting) in all films and clips is mandatory.



copy & property rights of works

- All members of any group participating in the Noor Student Competition can not participate in another competition until the results have been announced. any group to violent the condition above shall be removed
- By submitting their produced film to participate in the Noor Student Competition, the members of the production team express their satisfaction with the legitimate and legal exploits of their submitted film in the competition.

- prizes worth up to 200 million Iranian toman to the best works of general category
- prizes worth up to 20 million Iranian toman to the top 3 works of special category
- special gratitude for research institutes and schools with the most participants
